Ticket Sales

Tickets will be sold during snack and lunch in the Activities Office. No tickets will be sold after school or during class time. No tickets will be sold at the door. Students must have their WHS ID and a signed/completed dance contract to purchase a ticket. Cash, check (made out to WHS), and credit/debit card accepted. Students must clear all financial obligations and have no outstanding disciplinary issues.

- On the last day of ticket sales, dance contracts will not be available unless:
 - \circ If the student is under 18 a parent must come in to sign the contract.
 - If the student is 18 or over they must show proof of age to receive the contract.
- Students who do not have their ID cards when purchasing tickets will need to buy a replacement card for \$10.
- Tickets are non-transferable. The dance will be held rain or shine.
- Space is limited to 1000 tickets.

Dance Guidelines

This agreement is to clarify expected behavior prior to, during and after the activity. Consequences for violating guidelines are delineated in accordance with the IUSD Policy.

- WHS students must have their student ID to enter the dance. No bags or purses allowed. Only students currently enrolled at WHS at the time of the dance will be admitted.
- Transportation and/or personal possessions are subject to search. No liquids. No food items (including gum and mints).
- Anyone in violation of the Warrior Code of Conduct and the Dress Code will not be admitted:

 No alteration of clothing may be made during the dance
 Dress/skirts must minimally be at least hand length
 No backless garments that extend below the waist
 No bare midriffs/excessively low cut tops

Dress/Skirt slits may be no higher than fingertip length No exposed undergarments/see through dresses/bare sides No bandanas, chains, canes, masks, or wigs

- Any student found to be "under the influence", or to have consumed, or in possession of alcohol or any other controlled substance will be asked to leave, suspended for up to 5 school days and excluded from school activities for up to 10 school days.
- Dancing

No pushing, shoving, moshing, or crowd surfing
No inappropriate or front to back touching

No prolonged public displays of affection No straddling legs

<u>First violation</u> = ID confiscated to be claimed from administrator after the dance, documented in discipline file <u>Second Violation</u> = Immediate removal from dance, documented in discipline file

- Students will not be admitted to the dance after 8:30 PM. Once students leave the dance, they may not return. No refunds if arrival time is missed.
- Students are expected to be picked up from the dance no later than 15 minutes after the dance is over. To honor the time of the WHS staff, we ask parents to plan accordingly. In case of an infraction involving a minor, a parent will be contacted to pick up their student from the dance. In the event that they can't be reached, the incident will be referred to the Irvine Police Department.
- Failure to comply with requests of any Staff member will result in immediate dismissal from the dance. No refunds will be provided if students are removed from the dance.
