# **Automotive Technology**

## Certified Nurse Assistant CNA Pre-Certification Internship

- Assist with bathing, dressing, feeding, ambulation.
- Practice infection control and reading vital signs.
- Understanding psychosocial needs of clients.
- Students must be age 16+ with transportation to site
- TB clearance, fingerprints rolled, vaccinations. See course description.
- Eligible to become a State Certified Nurse Assistant upon completion of a 75% or better.
- One semester, 10 credits



# Medical Nursing Careers Internship

- Internships assigned in the hospital Patient rights, skills, and procedures
- Vital signs, nutrition
- Emergency procedures
- Long term patient care
- Neurological and trauma nursing
- Surgical; oncology Orthopedic nursing
- Observation and charting

Must be 16+ years of age with transportation to internship site Physical exam, TB clearance and vaccinations required prior to internship Semester class 5 units

## EMR to EMT

#### **EMR: Juniors and Seniors One semester**

- Learn about careers in fire service, sports medicine, coaching, lifeguarding.
  - Learn CPR principals, first aid skills, patient assessment and triage.
  - Gain hands-on experience delivering CPR on test dummies, wrapping wounds with gauze and how to safely apply a stent to a patient arm.
    - Must pass with 80% or higher to advance to EMT.

#### **EMT: Seniors only, year long**

- Successful completion makes student eligible to take the National Registry EMT- basic certification exam.
- Certification for: FEMA Incident Command System 100, 200, 700 & 800.

- Attend the first class or you will be automatically dropped.
- Attend class regularly



# Dropping an ROP Class

- A student is automatically dropped if he/she is absent from the first class meeting.
- Students may have until the 7th week to drop a course with no grade penalty. After the 7th week, a dropping student may receive a W or F on their transcript. Please ask your ROP teacher
- Students should contact their ROP teacher and counselor if dropping a course.
- Parent must send an email to <u>info@coastlinerop.net</u> for a student to drop an ROP course.



## What if I'm on the Waitlist?

- Students who are on the waitlist or wish to be in the class as a drop in student should attend class on the first day.
- The teacher will then add students to the roster in order of those on the waitlist and those who drop in.
