Winter Formal Guest Dance Contract

Saturday, February 5th, 2022 || 7-11pm || Knott's Berry Farm

Following are expectations provided by Woodbridge High School for guests at dances and similar events. The simple expectation is that students show respect for the event and those around them by dressing in an appropriate manner and behaving in a manner consistent with the Warrior Code of Conduct. By acknowledging this document, the student and parent are stating the student will act in a manner consistent with both the actual and the spirit of the expectations set forth.

The big idea behind these expectations is that events put on by WHS are public school events and therefore must consider all students wishing to participate. These events are designed to be wholesome, fun, and dignified events with the intent to help develop students' social skills and awareness. This agreement is to clarify expected behavior prior to, during and after WHS dances. Consequences for violating guidelines are delineated in accordance with the IUSD Policy. Attending school dances and other similar events is a privilege that can be revoked.

Guest Dance Guidelines

Behavior

For All Dances:

- Guests must check into the dance at the same time as the WHS student who purchased their ticket, and guests must bring valid school ID.
- Guests must be in good standing at their high school and have approval from school administrator, including signatures on guest dance contract with attached business card/school stamp.
- Transportation (including buses, cars, or other vehicles) and/or personal possessions are subject to search.
- No liquids allowed. No food items (including gum and mints) allowed.
- Once students leave the dance, they may not return.
- Latest allowable arrival time is 90 minutes after opening.
- No refunds if arrival time is missed.
- Dancing shall remain appropriate for school functions.
 - No inappropriate or excessive touching (including pushing, shoving, crowd surfing, etc.)
 - No prolonged public displays of affection
 - No front to back touching
 - No straddling legs
 - First violation = ID confiscated, to be claimed from administrator after the dance, documented in discipline file
 - Second Violation = Immediate removal from dance, documented in discipline file
- Any student found to be "under the influence", or to have consumed, or in possession of alcohol or any other controlled substance will be asked to leave, suspended for 5 school days and excluded from school activities for up to 10 school days.
- Failure to comply with requests of any Staff member will result in immediate dismissal from the dance. No refunds will be provided if students are removed from the dance.
- Students are expected to be picked up from the dance no later than 15 minutes after the dance is over. To honor the time of the WHS staff, we ask parents to plan accordingly. In case of an infraction involving a minor, a parent will be contacted to pick up their student from the dance. In the event that they can't be reached, the incident will be referred to the Irvine Police Department.
- Students are discouraged from bringing any valuables that will not remain on their person throughout the duration of the dance. WHS and IUSD are in no way responsible for lost, stolen, or vandalized items.
- Anyone in violation of the Warrior Code of Conduct will not be admitted.
- For students arriving in a group: If a controlled substance is found on anyone in the group, all students in the group will be barred entry to the dance.

Off-Campus Dances:

- Small bags and purses may be allowed at discretion of security checkpoint staff, and will be searched. Students need their school ID for entry.

Dress

For All Dances:

- Anyone in violation of the WHS Dress Code will not be admitted.
- No alteration of clothing may be made during the dance.
- Dress/skirts must minimally be at least hand length; dress/skirt slits may be no higher than fingertip length
- No exposed undergarments/see through dresses/bare sides
- No bare midriffs/excessively low cut tops
- No backless garments that extend below the waist
- No bandanas, chains, canes, masks, wigs, or other similar accessories

For Formal and Semi-Formal Dances:

- Attire must match the occasion (i.e., dresses, button-up shirts, ties, slacks, shoes, etc.). No jeans allowed.
